DETAILS OF SESSION:

Aim/ Objective:	The main aim of the program was to guide students in completing their scholarship forms without difficulty. The objectives included introducing the participants to the details of the MHA DBT Scholarship scheme and its benefits, clarifying eligibility conditions for both fresh and renewal applicants, and providing a clear, step-by-step demonstration of how to fill out the application form online.
Description Details:	The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has introduced the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Scholarship Scheme with the objective of supporting the education of eligible students, particularly those belonging to specific categories notified by the Government. To ensure that students are fully aware of the eligibility conditions, the documents required, and the correct procedure for filling out the application form, an Orientation and Guidance Session was organized. This session served as a platform to inform students about the scholarship, familiarize them with the online application portal, and reduce the chances of rejection due to errors in the application. The session also focused on educating students about the correct method of uploading documents, the importance of accuracy in bank details, and ensuring Aadhaar linkage for smooth disbursement.


